Cambridge South: a new station in the south of Cambridge

Network Rail is developing plans for a new station in the vicinity of the Cambridge Biomedical Campus to improve connectivity in Cambridgeshire.

The new station will help to improve accessibility for patients and visitors to Addenbrooke's and Royal Papworth hospitals, as well as better connections to proposed new housing developments across the Cambridge Southern Fringe.

Improving connectivity to the region will support the growth of the Cambridge Biomedical Campus and help it maintain both national and global competitiveness, attracting skilled workers from a wider catchment area.
