## Parson's Tunnel to Teignmouth Resilience Project



The railway is a vital artery, which connects communities, businesses and visitors in 50 towns and cities in the South West with the rest of the UK. Since the damage caused by heavy storms which resulted in a six week closure of the railway in 2014, Network Rail has been developing plans to improve resilience of the railway between Exeter and Newton Abbot.

The 1.8km section of railway between Parson's Tunnel to Teignmouth needs to be better protected from cliff falls, land slips and from damage caused by the sea during extreme weather. Network Rail is consulting on proposals to realign the tracks to make room for corrective measures that will stabilise the cliffs and therefore protect the railway for generations to come. The proposals include new amenities such as new and improved walking routes.
